

Compost Lot Drop-Off Guidelines/Definitions

Vegetative Matter - means any yard or landscaping waste, including leaves, grass, brush, limbs, and branches resulting from residential, commercial, industrial, and agricultural operations or from community activities.

Contaminated Loads - means brush and leaves mixed together containing a preponderance of leaves; loads containing bags of vegetative matter exceeding five (5) percent of the load by volume; inert material such as soil, gravel, bricks, concrete, asphalt, or building materials; waste wood, and pallets either alone or in combination with vegetative matter; and any mixed municipal solid waste of any percent in a load of vegetative matter.

Compost - means the product produced by the composting of vegetative matter and other types of organic material in a relatively stable form.

Composting - as used by these rules means the controlled biological decomposition of the organic component of vegetative matter and other types of organic material.

Contractor - means any person, group, or organization engaged in any activity resulting in the generation of vegetative matter who regularly offers themselves for hire or has been hired or compensated for the work.

Contractor Tipping Fee - \$20.00 per load any size.

NISWMD - means the Northeast Indiana Solid Waste Management District. (260) 587-3063

Use of Facility - means residents, companies, and organizations have paid all fees required, read, and complied with facility use rules, and may bring vegetative matter to the site where registered, during public use hours or those hours specifically authorized by this rule.

Accepted Items: Paper & Cardboard

Newspapers and all inserts catalogs, phone books, file folders,

Office paper, glossy paper, envelopes, junk mail, magazines, paper bags, flattened cardboard boxes, paperboard boxes (ie: cereal boxes), cases from pop, frozen food boxes

(remove any plastic bags from inside), Hard cover books (hard covers must be removed and put in the trash) shredded paper, paper cups

No wrapping paper of any kind,

Glass Bottles and Jars:

Clear and colored glass containers
Containers should be rinsed and empty.

NOT Accepted:

Flat glass, window panes, light bulbs, dinnerware drink-ware, ceramics, Pyrex glassware

Plastics Accepted:

Milk Jugs, Pop bottles, laundry detergent bottles, spray bottles(without nozzle)

NOT Accepted:

Plastic totes and lids, 5 gal buckets, cat litter containers,
